

Instructions for SLG Bisley members using the Spott

Use of the Spott for accommodation is a privilege extended to BDMP members by the BDMP in accordance with their rules, translated below for reference. It is essential that we obey these rules – the specifics for SLG Bisley members vary from the standard rules as follows.

All applications from SLG Bisley members for use of the Spott should be channelled through Charles Murton who will submit a consolidated application to the BDMP. Approval can take a few weeks so please apply as far as possible in advance. Please note that there's no point applying to use the Spott at those times of year when it's likely to be in use by visiting German teams, e.g. during the Phoenix, Imperial and Trafalgar meetings.

A fee of £10 , £20 for guests, per person per day is to be paid to the SLG Bisley Treasurer instead of the €10 / €20 fee mentioned below. The fee is to be paid as soon as possible after the Spott has been used. Overall charges for SLG Bisley Spott usage will be settled with the BDMP by the Treasurer.

Charles will hold a Spott key. It will only be checked out to an SLG Bisley member if approval for that member to use the Spott has been confirmed by the BDMP. The key is only to be handled by SLG Bisley members and must be kept by one of them at all times while it is checked out. In any event, the member collecting it from Charles will be held responsible for the key if it is lost.

It is imperative that we treat the clubhouse well and that we are seen to do so. If you discover any problems with the building when you arrive – damage, blown bulbs, leaks, whatever – please report this to Charles asap. Before you leave, check again and make sure everything is in good order.

Please note: *basic cleaning of all rooms is now mandatory for everyone using the Spott. Please ensure that the whole building is left clean, tidy and in good condition.*

BDMP Rules for Use of the "Spott" clubhouse on the NRA site in Bisley / Surrey, UK

The use of the clubhouse "The Spott" in Bisley is open to all BDMP members. Members of official BDMP eV teams, where the BDMP is funding the travel costs of team members, will have priority for the use of the building. If more than one official team wishes to use the Spott at the same time, and agreement cannot be reached between the teams, priority will be given to those team members who submitted their application earliest.

Private use of the clubhouse by BDMP members is permitted for any purpose provided that this does not conflict with any official BDMP use of the building. A charge of €10 per person per day is levied for private use of the Spott. Any BDMP member staying in the clubhouse on a private basis may be accompanied by non-members provided that a fee of €20 per person per day fee is paid for each of them.

Any application for use of the Spott must be submitted in writing, using the appropriate form, to the BDMP Federal Office and approved by Mr. Ulrich Kwade on behalf of the BDMP Board. The application form can be obtained from the BDMP Federal Office.

The Spott key will be sent by the Federal Office to the successful applicant. It must be returned to the Federal Office by registered mail no more than one day after the end of the stay.
